Discounts for those in receipt of benefits

Please note that if your child is in receipt of free school meals or you can prove that you are in receipt of one of the following benefits you will be entitled to the discounted price.

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

Unless your child is already receiving free school meals, we will need to see documentary proof that you are receiving one of these benefits.
