Activities:

We are learning to:

- Hear rhyming words
- Orally blend sounds in words
- Follow the rules and routines
- Begin to speak in more detail at Circle Time
- Take part in small and large group activities
- Share and take turns with support
- Recognise numerals to 5/10 or beyond
- Count objects and actions
- Recognise/write own name
- Use large equipment in PE with increasing skill and confidence
- Listen attentively in small and large group activities.

We encourage the children to be as independent as possible in the Nursery. Please can you encourage your child to put their own coats and shoes and socks on at home? They can also begin to do up their own coats etc. This will help your child greatly at Nursery.
